On February 10, 1995 Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel filed a pleading entitled "Stipulation" in which they informed the Disciplinary Tribunal that they have entered into an "amicable agreement" regarding Respondent's compliance with our January 27, 1995 Order requiring him to pay Disciplinary Counsel's legal fees. As a respondent and a disciplinary counsel cannot stipulate away a Disciplinary Tribunal Order, we consider the pleading a motion to affirm the parties' stipulated agreement, and hereby grant it, with the understanding that Disciplinary Counsel henceforth look to Respondent for payment of his fees.
