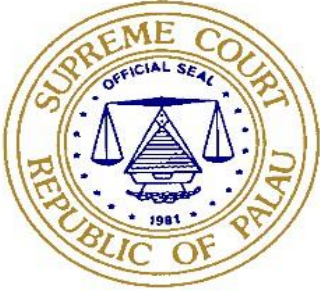
Re: Palau Judiciary welcomes New Court Counsel for 2017-2018 Term
