While in Law School, she partook in the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition and the Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot. At Cornell, she was Notes Editor on the International Law Journal. Prior to joining the Court, Kathryn-Ann



was an Associate at Cravath, Swaine & Moore in New York City, where she was the co-captain of the corporate sailing team. Most importantly, Kathryn-Ann is joined by her dog, Whisper.



Liam comes to the Palau Judiciary from Washington D.C. British on his father's side, Liam was born in Zimbabwe and has lived in South Africa, Singapore, Indonesia, Hungary, the United Kingdom, USA, and a number of other countries.
