

Application for Admission to the Palau Bar Form C: Admission by Examination

In addition to being of good moral character, admission to the Palau Bar by examination requires a passing score on four different portions of the Exam. The Exam is comprised of the Multistate Bar Examination (MBE), the Multistate

Performance Test (MPT) I & II, the MPRE, a Palauan-based Essay Examination, and Multistate Essay Examination (MEE). The Exam is offered annually in July of each year.

Applicants who have taken and passed the MBE, the MEE, the MPT I & II, or the MPRE in a state or territorial jurisdiction of the United States within the past 5 years are not required to take that particular examination again, but applicants are required to provide official documentation of a score that would be deemed a passing grade on the Palau Bar Examination. Palau accepts transfers of scores of 120 and higher on the MBE, 65 or higher on the MEE and MPT I & II, and 75 or higher on the MPRE. All applicants must take and pass the Palau-based Essay Examination.

An application may be summarily rejected if this form is not filled out completely.
